The deadline for submission of proposals is midnight, Pacific Time, on February 9, 2009

Proposals should be submitted as follows (all three elements are required):

*All three elements are required.* It is sufficient for paper copy to be postmarked by the submission deadline, but in any event it must be received no later than 12:00 noon on the next working day after the electronic submission deadline, including the date signed and the binding original signature of the vendor's authorized representative. There should be a place for the Applicant to sign and date, if your bid is accepted. It is the sole responsibility of the respondents to ensure that their responses arrive in a timely manner. The Applicant has the right but not the obligation to reject all late or incomplete submissions, as the Applicant determines to be in its own best interest, or to contact vendors such as to seek ministerial corrections. The Applicant has the right but not the obligation to determine a short list for final negotiations and contract revisions after the submission deadline or to accept the winning proposal and execute it as is.

Oral and telephone bids will not be considered, nor will modifications of proposals by such communication be considered. The completed proposal form shall be without erasures or alterations. Delivery of the proposals will be considered authorization by the Vendor to make a contract, if awarded.
